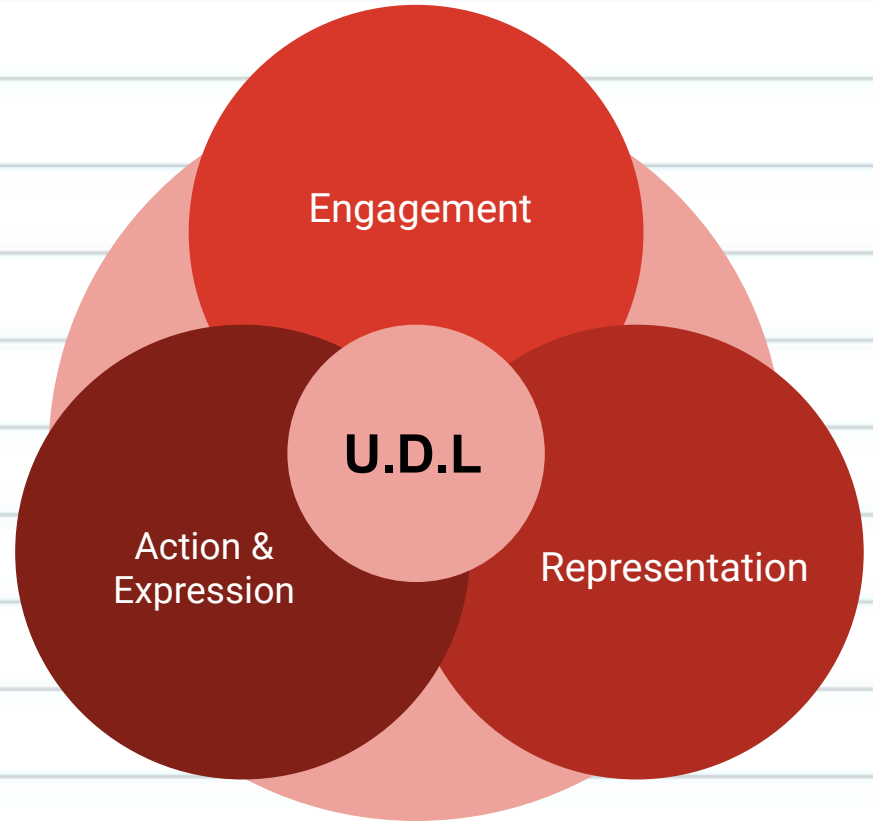

3. *Representation*

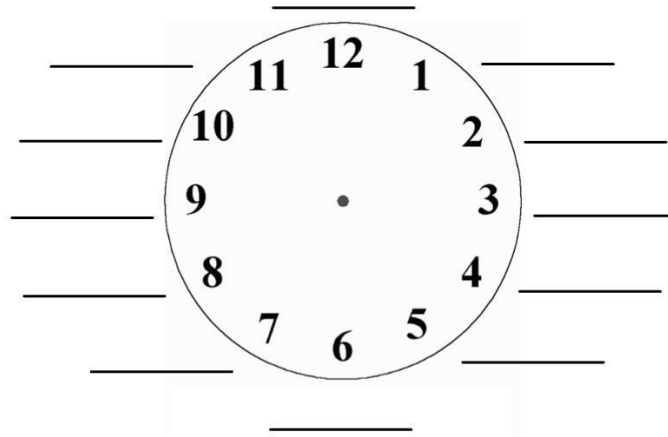


